Project Name: Georgia Lane to Britt / Highpoint Road Parallel Route

Cost: \$1,326,893

Detailed Description and Justification: This project shall serve as a form of “Access Management” that can be associated with the GDOT Safety project, which removes the reversible lane system. In order to promote pedestrian activity within this Corridor the design for this project will include sidewalks, pedestrian crossings, pedestrian refuge islands and landscaped buffers. This project is included within the “Five Year Implementation Plan” for the Highway 78 LCI Corridor Study. The proposed project will provide a parallel service road, south of US 78 between Georgia Lane and Highpoint Road.
