

# Project Fact Sheet #5

**Project Name:** Yellow River Pedestrian Bridge

**Cost:** \$648,200 [programmed Scott HPP / GW333 / 8034 / F-0558-02]

**Detailed Description and Justification:** The proposed pedestrian crossing will be constructed as a safe transportation alternative for individuals located within the established, as well as future, residential and commercial properties along US 78. The current bridge crossing at the Yellow River will not be expanded as part of the current GDOT safety project, which removes the reversible lane system and installs a median. Sidewalks within the GDOT safety project will be reduced from four to three feet at this location, which will create an even more dangerous situation for pedestrians. In order to separate pedestrians from the dangerous conditions created from the close proximity of vehicular traffic along US 78, this parallel pedestrian crossing at the Yellow River will provide a safe transportation alternative for pedestrians.
